China and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Possessing typical Qing-style, it is well-known for the exquisite beauty of its magnificent halls and the various sizes, shapes and colors of the buildings. Later visit the **National Embroidery Institute** to see silk embroidery, an important local craft. This evening enjoy a **Traditional Dinner & Music Show**.

Meals: (B,L,D) Overnight: Suzhou

Day 6: Suzhou - Hangzhou

This morning transfer to **Hangzhou**, which is well-known for its beautiful natural scenery. Visit the **Economic Development Zone** with a briefing on investment opportunity. Later visit **Lingyin Temple**, one of the ten most famous Buddhist temples in China and considered a leading center for research relative to Chinese Buddhist culture.

Day 7: Hangzhou - Shanghai

This morning enjoy a **West Lake Boat Cruise** for some of the most beautiful scenery in China. Many ancient poets write their poems based on West Lake. Day 8: Shanghai
